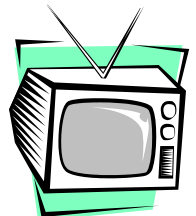

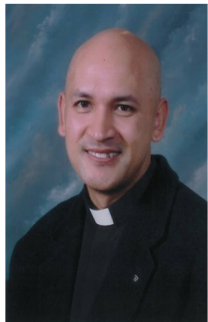
Our Under-Understood Mystery of Faith

For most of us, the Ascension is anti-climatic. It marks the “almost” end of the Easter season. Beyond this, the Ascension means that Jesus stopped appearing to people on earth. And, truth be told, most of us would prefer the Ascension hadn’t Happened - we’d much prefer to see Jesus ourselves, today! The Ascension is meant to be more than this. The Ascension is critical as we cycle from death into new life. Our lives Experience “ascension” when we get a new job, but before they arrive.

At the Ascension there is still loss, still “death” happening. We are letting go of what was, of our old life. And we are not quite at the Resurrection and Pentecost. We are not fully experiencing new life, Yet

With the Ascension, we know new life is coming. But, first we must transition. Transition from death. Transition into the new life that awaits us. This is the key, the “kerygma” of Ascension-time.

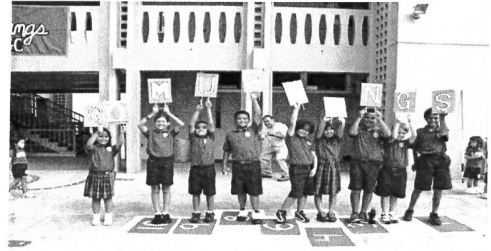
