Most of my adult life, I have struggled to understand what Jesus means about the Kingdom of Heaven. When and where is He talking?

To help me, I try to remember something I once heard that the Kingdom of Heaven exists in the here and now; the Kingdom is our responsibility today. (Dare I say, our responsibility as stewards?!) The Kingdom exists any moment we allow the Holy Spirit to work through us. I try to remember this whenever I hear a Gospel like today's and feel confused about Jesus' message.

And, then too, I also think of Vatican II, to one of the few passages I basically know by heart. In ***Lumen Gentium*** (The Dogmatic Constitution on the Church) we are told that "the laity, by their vocation, seek the kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs...led by the spirit of the Gospel, (the laity) may work for the sanctification of the world from within as a leaven" (No. 31).

Jesus and the Church Fathers are talking about you and me! **WE** are yeast in the world, bringing about God's Kingdom in the here and now!

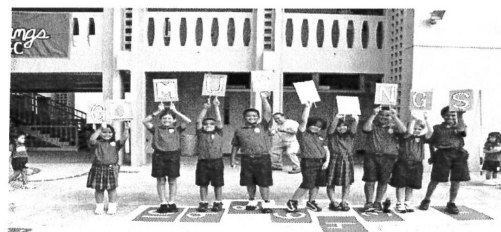
