# Who "Eats Locust" for You? By: Kristina Ml. DeNeve Adult Faith Formation Coordinator Diocese of Honolulu

Last week's Gospel stated we need to be alert because we do not know when the end will come. Now today's Gospel emphasizes John the Baptist. Since these are the first Gospels of our "Christian New Year," they are obviously important. But, what does John eating locusts have to do with us, this December of 2014?

One answer is that we also need messengers to help us prepare the way of the Lord. Yet ironically, prophets no longer exists - we believe John was the last prophet.
