

Are You Saved? An Answer Based on Divine Mercy Sunday

Have you ever been asked if you are saved? The quick answer would be yes, that through my baptism. I pray and hope that I am saved. Unfortunately, as a Catholic Christian, I cannot and will not definitively say, "Yes, I know I am saved." I cannot say this because of my understanding of and reliance on Divine Mercy, celebrated today, within this solemn, holy octave (eight days) of Easter.

Divine Mercy reminds me that it is not up to me whether I am saved or not. It is only by God's mercy that anyone is saved. Saying I am saved does not make it happen. In the end, it is up to God, not me. I do not initiate salvation - I can only respond to God's mercy.

This is a kernel of what we celebrate today. At the height of our current celebration of Jesus' resurrection, we also take time to acknowledge the overwhelming abundance of God's mercy. So great is that mercy that God actually died for us and now desires to bring us with Jesus to salvation, to share in Jesus' new life.
