
Jesus' experience with the woman with the hemorrhage in today's Gospel is a great metaphor of what it is like when we share our faith. First, we are like Jesus, walking through our days, living our life. As lay people, we are called to be "leaven in the world." Second, like Jesus, we do not know who we will encounter and what will be needed from us. Like Jesus, we share our faith simply by how we react to someone bumping into us in a crowd. 
