Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

April 12 & 13, 2014

Isaiah 50:4-7 The suffering Servant speaks to the weary.
Psalm 22 "My god, my God, why have you Abandon me?"
Philippians 2:6-11 Jesus emptied himself, and accepted death on a cross.
Matthew 26:14-27:66 They come to a place called Golgotha and crucified Jesus there.
 Or 27:11-54

Our readings today focus on the great sacrifice that Jesus has made because of His love for us. The proclamation from Isaiah portrays God's servant who hears God's voice and does not turn back. Saint Paul tells us that Jesus' sacrifice is what led to his glorification and our salvation. And in the Passion according to Saint Matthew, the Roman centurion proclaims what Peter could not bring himself to say: "Truly, this was the Son of God!" As we listen today, let us ask for the grace to recognize and acknowledge God's saving action in our own lives.

The Mystery of the Cross

Why did Jesus die? What is the meaning behind Jesus' passion and death? If these are questions you think you already have a handle on, that you have a pretty good understanding of today's Gospel, think again.

The Cross is one of the central mysteries of the Christian faith. To say it is a mystery means that whatever you think you know about the Cross is more untrue than true.

Whatever you understand is a small tip of a very large iceberg, indeed, a molecule compared to the universe.

To be reminded of this is not meant to discourage us. Quite the opposite. The things we understand are easily set aside and dismissed. When we "get" something, it is then beneath us, something we can control and even manipulate. But mysteries? Mysteries can only be experienced, felt, touched, entered into. This week in particular this most Holy Week, spend some time with Jesus, experiencing anew His mystery.

Divine Mercy Sunday Series III

Be Merciful to Others

Jesus gave us a new commandment. He said, "Love one another as I have loved you". All His life He showed us how to love others actively, how to be compassionate, forgiving and thoughtful.

Jesus told Sr. Faustina about the importance of doing acts of mercy. He said, I demand from you deeds of mercy which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse yourself from it...Even the strongest faith is of no avail without works (Diary 742). If a soul does not exercise mercy in some way, it will not obtain My mercy on the day of judgment (1317).

We can exercise mercy through our actions, our words and our prayers.

The Corporal Works of Mercy::

1. Feed the hungry; 2. Give drink to the thirsty; 3. Clothe the naked; 4. Shelter the homeless; 5. Comfort the imprisoned; 6. Visit the sick; 7. Bury the dead.

The Spiritual Works of Mercy are:

1. Admonish sinners; 2. Instruct the uninformed; 3. Counsel the doubtful; 4. Comfort the sorrowful; 5. Be patient with those in error; 6. Forgive offenses; 7. Pray for the living and the dead.
