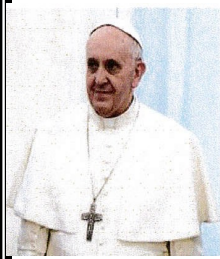

Can You Hear Me Now?

Today's Gospel comes after Jesus heals the blind man, indeed, right after the blind man is thrown out of the temple and begins following Jesus. His sight restored, he could "see" what the elders could not. Now Jesus moves from the seeing to hearing - we can see our master, we can hear our master.

This is very good news for us Easter people. I mean, how often do you feel lost and wonder what to do about something? Don't you also struggle, as I do, to figure out what we are supposed to do in certain situations?

And what does Jesus tell us? Not that it will be easy or obvious.

Rather, Jesus says that if we follow him, ultimately, we will know His voice. Ultimately, we will recognize and do His will. Ultimately, it all works out in the end; we have life and have it more abundantly. We will not be led astray.

All we need to do is to continue to desire to follow Jesus and He will call us by name and lead us out. Great Easter news!
