### ***When Sailors' Skills Are Not Enough***

The disciples' journey in today's Gospel is much like our daily life. We are already followers of Jesus, baptized and regularly fed by Scripture and Eucharist. When we sense Jesus telling us to do something, we try our best to do it.

So we set out in the boat as asked. How many times are we then surprised shocked or angered when things do not go well?! Jesus told them to get in the boat, but he did not necessarily promise smooth sailing.

Facing the storm, the disciples used their sailing expertise. And we too use our skills when problems arise. Unfortunately, however, talents often are not enough - for them or for us. When we completely focus on the wind, our problems can still overwhelm us. (Note too that this entire pattern repeats itself again with Peter!)

Life's troubles only end when Jesus reaches out to them. Jesus provides what is most needed. Then we see the disciples get it right: self-congratulations are not warranted, only praise and worship of God. God help me remember this story the next time the storms come!

### **Religious Education Dept.**

You may now download the registration forms and calendars for our Faith Formation classes starting on September 7, 2014. For students receiving the Sacrament of Eucharist we will need a copy of the child's Baptism Certificate & for Confirmation students, we will need copies of the Baptism & Eucharist Certificate. The students in both Eucharist & Confirmation must be enrolled in the program for 2 consecutive years. Every student must complete a general registration form including those receiving the Sacraments.

In order for a person to receive any of the three (3) sacraments in 2015, he/she must be enrolled and participate in RCIA by the Rite of Welcoming in October.

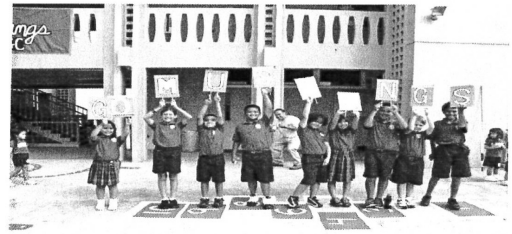
