***Living Catholic in the 808: It's Good to Be Here***

Among its other attributes, the Eucharist is meant imply to be a family meal, a community celebration, a place, like our kitchen tables and living rooms, where we come together to be with each other.

The Eucharist invites us to gather as a family. They don't just gather when some (special) occasion merits the effort. They come together regularly, despite tedium, boredom, low energy, busyness, distractions and interpersonal tensions. Family life is as much about sharing the mundane as it is about sharing special and joyous moments.

Families are for every day, just as they are for special occasions. So too is the Eucharist. I wish I had known this as a child; on feast days like Christmas and Easter (I never) connected (Eucharist) with the much-anticipated family dinner we would be having later.

I wish, too, that people would know this when they stay away from church because of boredom or anger or because they feel their presence there is only social and not an act of prayer.

One of the reasons we go to church is to prayer, but we go there, too, for the same reason we go to the family table every evening. It's good to be there, no matter what!"

**The Gift of Divine Mercy**

**(or complete cleansing of the Soul)**

Jesus loved us so much that He endured ridicule, betrayal and excruciating pain from torture prior to His death on the cross. He was aware of our human frailty of repetitive sins. Therefore, Jesus promised to St. Faustina, on the Feast of Mercy, a grace equaled only by the grace of Holy Baptism. This means that on this day, your soul can become as clean as a newly baptized baby. Should you die immediately after receiving this extraordinary grace on the Feast of Mercy, you would go straight to heaven with no Purgatory to serve at all. However, in order to receive this grace, Jesus attached conditions for the proper observance of this Feast.

1. The Feast should be preceded by a Novena of Chaplets to the Divine Mercy, beginning on Good Friday.
2. The Sermon on that day should be on Divine Mercy; that is the mercy which God the Father bestows on us through Jesus Christ His Son.
3. That we contemplate on this day the Mystery of Redemption as the greatest revelation of Divine Mercy towards us.
4. The image of the Divine Mercy is to be ceremoniously blessed.
5. The image is to be publicly venerated. In this instance the image should be exposed to all taking part in the celebration and an image left in a position that all can touch and say, "Jesus I Trust in You." This is carried out as people leave the Church if number prevent it during the ceremony.
6. Confession and Communion on the day or 7 days prior Or after the Feast of Mercy. Communion is to be a Worthy one on this day and must be accompanied by Complete "Trust in Divine Mercy."
7. That an act of Mercy should take place in our lives in The days prior or subsequent to the feast.
