- Scriptures are not just inspiring writings but writings inspired by the Holy Spirit.
- The Proclamation of Scriptures at Mass is Christ speaking to his people.
- The Lectionary contains Scripture readings on a three-year cycle (Sundays) and a two-year cycle (weekdays)
- Year A, Matthew; Year B, Mark (and John 6); Year C, Luke.
- John is read during Christmas and Easter seasons and a few other times during the year.

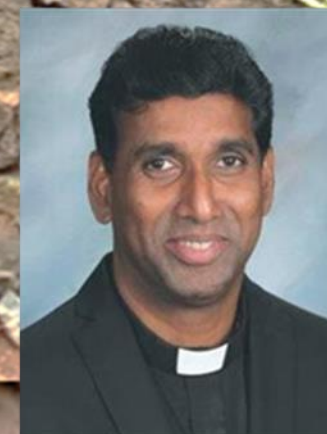
