

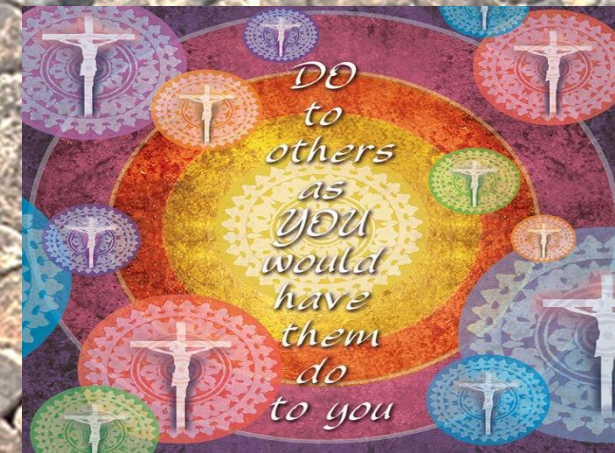

From the Pastor's Desk:

*"I give you a new commandment, says the Lord: love one another as I have loved you."
John 13:34*

Today's readings invite us to think and act in a very different way than what our impulses prompt us to. This is in contrast to the world's and society's thinking or acting. It is to love and do good to our enemies or adversaries.

In Jesus' time, society operated on a system of reciprocity and revenge. People repaid kindness with kindness and hatred with hatred. If someone hurts, you then you hurt that person back. This was perfectly lawful and accepted. "Tit for Tat" retaliation was the norm.

Then Jesus invited us to a radical new perspective. It is a divine perspective that tells us to love our enemy and be merciful and kind to our adversaries; regardless of what they did or whether they deserve it or not. It is one of the hardest teachings of Jesus to accept. However, to be a true and authentic disciple and follower of Jesus and to be deserving of heaven, we are called to obey Jesus.

May the Holy Spirit enlighten and empower us to be forgiving and show love to our enemies and offenders.
May Our Lady of Good Counsel intercede for us.
