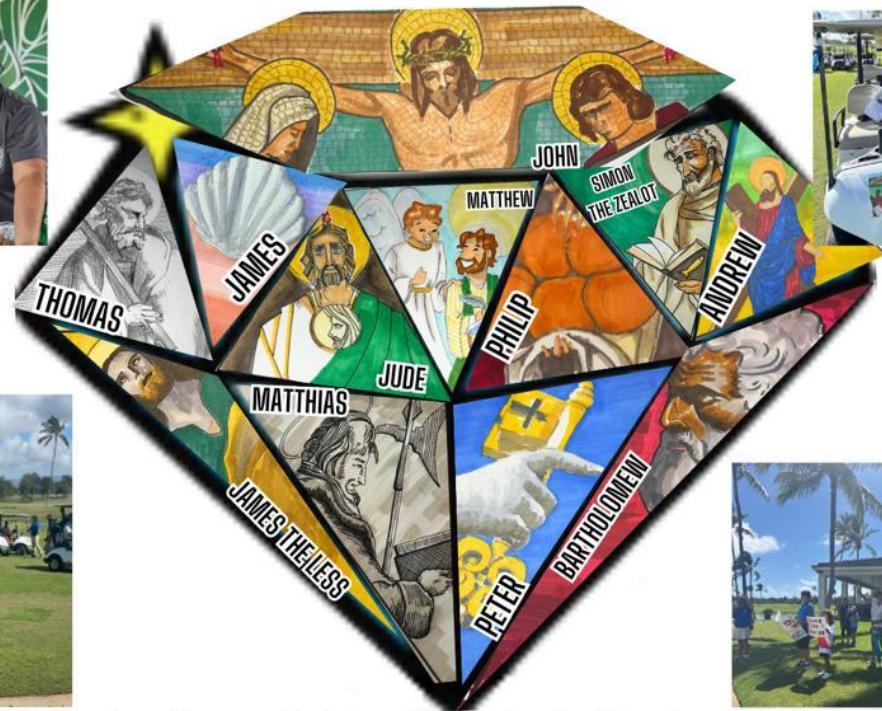


We Did It!
