From the Pastor's Desk:

*"You believe in me, Thomas, because you have seen me, says the Lord; blessed are they who have not seen me, but still believe."
John 20:29*

The Lord is risen, and we have seen the empty tomb and the wounds on his resurrected human body. The resurrection that took place two thousand years ago is a transformative event, marking a new beginning for all of creation. Through the resurrection, God embraces creation and redeems it with the precious blood of his only son, Jesus Christ.

We all experience painful moments and events in our lives, and death often feels like the most profound challenge. The loss of parents, spouses, children, or other loved ones can plunge us into moments of darkness, leaving us struggling to cope with the pain and unsure of how to respond to such deep wounds. It is in these moments that Jesus' resurrection offers us hope and light.

We are repeatedly told that he has conquered death. Jesus comes to us, saying, "Look at my empty tomb and my wounds. I am not a myth or a character in a storybook, but I am God, present in your lives. You will rise from this moment and time of pain and darkness. I will lead you to a place of light, peace, and love. Ultimately, you will be with me eternally, for I am merciful."

May the Holy Spirit empower us to believe in the Resurrection and the salvation found in Jesus.
